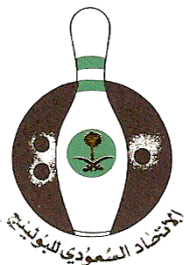



I wanted to tell you what a pleasure it has been to work with you during the past year. I enjoyed our many hours of discussion regarding coaching philosophy and team strategies . I learned a great deal. You surprised many people here when you wanted to learn about the "helicopter". The thai bowlers could not believe that an American would be so open minded to learn the "asain style" especially since it is not accepted in the west.

You understand how difficult it was for the bowlers communicate with a coach that is from another country. You really understand how to communicate with the bowler regardless of the language barrier, making the leaning process easy. I especially like how you use the vedeo camera to show the bowlers directly what they need to work on.

I had many good experiences from last year, like the indescribable feeling to be a part Team Thailand when we won the FIQ Gold medal in Reno. But I must say the most memorable moment of the past year was when you and I, together, coached Kitchawat and Jilaporn to the men's doubles Gold medal in the 1995 SEA Games. It was Thailand's first Gold medal of the competition. I remember saying to you "We did it". It was a very emotional moment.

It is unfortunate that the political climate in thailand will not allow the T.T.B.C. to hire a coach in 1996. I know that I will miss working with you. If for any reason you need a reference for future coaching opportunities, do not hesitate to use my name. I will be happy to give you a very positive recommendation.

Mike, you will always be my brother and you are always welcome to my home. I hope you will be able to come back to Thailand. I wish you the best of luck with your coaching career and a very happy life.
